Also, there is a concern about people already think Highlands Park is a public park and the round-up could perpetuate this problem. Lastly discussed was when the round-up could be held and since there is no lighting at the park, it was decided it could not be held in the evenings and during the day on the weekends would most likely not be successful.

Lisa Cromwell submitted her self-nomination for the LifeStyle Committee and was invited to join the committee. She hopes to generate some interest in community events.

Mike B said the bushes at the corner of Turkey Creek/Hayfield need to be trimmed.
